

Call for Project Funding in Cancer Research from the Sjöberg Foundation - Nomination of Research Proposals from the Faculty of Medicine

In 2017, the Sjöberg Foundation approved six project grants of in total 36 million SEK; 2018 eleven project grants of in total 50,2 million SEK and for 2019 ten project grants of a total 45 million SEK were approved. For 2020, the Sjöberg Foundation has again decided to support cancer research projects of high quality.

Please note: For this year, the project proposals are to be sent directly to the Sjöberg Foundation The call is for

- 1) Research in health care science and complementary and integrative medicine for cancer patients.
- 2) Cancers with poor prognosis that is difficult to treat

According to the donator, methods in unconventional treatment methods during cancer treatment are welcome.

The last day for submission of project proposals to the Sjöberg foundation March, 31. Researchers that are invited to send in a full application will be notified around June, 10 and last day for submission of the full application is **September, 10**.

- Expected results and expected time when the results of the proposal are applicable and the expected effects in health care. <2000 signs
