Call for Project Funding in Cancer Research from the Sjöberg Foundation - Nomination of Research Proposals from the Faculty of Medicine

In 2017, the Sjöberg Foundation approved six project grants of in total 36 million SEK; 2018 eleven project grants of in total 50,2 million SEK and for 2019 ten project grants of a total 45 million SEK were approved. For 2020, the Sjöberg Foundation has again decided to support cancer research projects of high quality.

Please note: For this year, the project proposals are to be sent directly to the Sjöberg Foundation. The call is for

- 1) Research in health care science and complementary and integrative medicine for cancer patients.**
- 2) Cancers with poor prognosis that is difficult to treat**

According to the donator, methods in unconventional treatment methods during cancer treatment are welcome.

The last day for submission of project proposals to the Sjöberg foundation **March, 31.**

Researchers that are invited to send in a full application will be notified around June, 10 and last day for submission of the full application is **September, 10.**

- **Expected results and expected time when the results of the proposal are applicable and the expected effects in health care.** <2000 signs
