## Collaboration award 2024

The Faculty board has decided to award a Collaboration Prize every two years. The next prize will be awarded in 2024.

The purpose of the prize is to draw attention to outstanding efforts in terms of collaboration between the activities within the Faculty of Science and Technology and external parties. Through this prize, employees receive recognition for such efforts while the work becomes known among colleagues and the outside world.

The prize sum, which is SEK 30,000, is awarded to individuals or groups within the faculty who have made significant efforts to increase collaboration between the activities at the faculty and external parties. The collaboration must contribute to developing and strengthening the faculty with regard to research and/or education. The person or persons nominated must have a permanent position at the faculty.

Different forms of initiatives and activities within the collaboration area can be rewarded. It can e.g. be dissemination of the university's competence, use of society's competence and mutual cooperation projects.

Employees at the Faculty of Science and Technology are invited to make suggestions for one or more prize winners. When nominating, a description of the nominee's activities and justification must be attached. The justification must take its starting point from the below examples of nomination grounds and contain concrete examples. It may be no more than two pages long (Georgia 11) and must be worded so that it is possible for the assessment committee to make a relevant assessment of the nominee's merits without having personal knowledge of the nominee(s).

The evaluation committee consists of the faculty's management team. The Faculty board will decide on prize winners on February 7, 2024, and the award ceremony will take place in connection with the Spring Promotion in May 2024.

## **Examples of nomination grounds**

- Developed and established new forms of collaboration or areas for collaboration.
- Actively participated in public dissemination of knowledge within the faculty's subject areas.
- Established long-term and fruitful collaborative projects.
- Through active participation in various public contexts, aroused interest in education and research at our faculty.
