


## 70<sup>th</sup> Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting

The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences in collaboration with the Ragnar Söderberg Foundation are responsible for recommending Swedish participants to the Lindau Review Panel. The panel then makes the final selection. Participation is fully funded by the Ragnar Söderberg Foundation and the Foundation Lindau Nobel Laureate Meetings.

The meeting will be held from 28 June-3 July 2020 on the island of Lindau, situated on Lake Constance in south Germany.
